Residents and members of the community may be aware that the Shute Harbour Marina proposal has been declared a 'significant project' that will require an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) in accordance with the *State Development and Public Works Organisation Act 1971*.

Environmental and technical studies into this proposal are proceeding, and the State Government's Coordinator General has recently published Terms of Reference that outline the issues that need to be considered in the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS).

Port Binnli Pty Ltd are the project managers of the new proposal, and they have appointed specialist environmental consultants, Cardno, to undertake the EIS. This EIS will provide an assessment of the potential impacts of the proposed development.

Port Binnli Pty Ltd has opened an Information Office at the Shute Harbour Transit Terminal.


Project Officer Steve Fisher is on site and is available to meet with local residents and boat owners to discuss the proposed project and the EIS process.
